# Quiver Pond

Survey Date: July 1, 2019 Last Surveyed: 2016

## Lake Description

Quiver Pond is 18.86-acres and has 0.78-miles of shoreline. It is located in the town of Webb, Herkimer County and lies within the Black River watershed. The team launched two canoes at the hand launch off South Shore Road.

## Aquatic Invasive Plant Presence

No invasive plants were detected.

## Native Plant Biota

Comprehensive surveys of all native plants found within the pond were not prioritized in 2019 as this data had previously been collected in 2016. Native plants detected included: *Eriocaulon* spp. (pipewort), *Nuphar variegata* (yellow pond lily), *Utricularia purpurea* (large purple bladderwort), *Brasenia schreberi* (watershield), *Chara* spp. (muskgrass), and *Potamogeton natans* (floating leaf pondweed).

## Aquatic Invasive Animal Presence

Sediment sieves were taken to determine the presence of *Corbicula fluminea* (Asian clams). None were found. Three plankton tows were also conducted with no invasive zooplankton detected.
